

Port Perry Angels Softball

Tournament Rules

Each team must show Proof of Insurance upon registering and must have it available at all times throughout the tournament if requested.

If playing outside of Ontario, teams must present a travel permit from their governing body.

PWSA "by-laws and regulation" and Softball Canada playing rules will apply and be followed.

Teams may register up to 17 players and all "pick up" players must submit a signed letter of permission from the player's team manager/coach. The letter of permission must be sent to the PWSA registrar prior to the tournament starting. The letter must also be submitted along with the team roster to the tournament headquarters before the first game is played. No players may be added once the roster is submitted.

Tournament headquarters is located at Joe Fowler Park South.

Pitching mound distance:

35" for Squirt 38" for Novice 40" for Bantam 43" for Midget

Teams must be ready to play at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled game time. A team will be allowed a 10 minute grace prior and then will have to forfeit game if 9 players cannot be fielded. The 10 minute or portion thereof will be part of the game time. In the event of a forfeit the score will be 7-0 and 0 points awarded to the forfeiting team.

Home team does not bat in last inning if leading. Two points will be awarded for a win, 1 point for the tie and 0 for the loss No points are awarded for crossover games 7 runs maximum per game No infield practice will be allowed on the game diamond

The home team will be decided by a flip of a coin by the home plate umpire and shall supply the official scorekeeper. Home team will also report the final score to the tournament headquarters located at Joe Fowler Park south after each game

Game time limits will be as follows. Each game will be 7 innings Round robin: No new inning to start after 1 hour and 30 minutes Elimination Games: No time limit Medal games: No time limit Mercy Rule: 10 run after 3 innings or 7 run after 5 innings

There are unlimited substitutions. Everyone can bat.

Safe-base rules will be in effect. Batting helmets are mandatory and will be checked by umpires prior to the start of each game. As per Softball Canada ruling, Titanium bats are illegal.

Protests will not be considered, UMPIRE DECISIONS ARE FINAL.

In the event of ties for playoffs positions after round robin play they will be settled by team with best plus/minus, if still tied least amount of runs scored against, and if still tied by a 3 inning game.

Rain Delay: If a game in progress is called due to rain it will resume from the points of interruption. Should the tournament be completely rained out before it starts, \$125.00 per team entry fee will be retained for administration expenses. If 50% or more of round robin is played the tournament is cancelled due to rain there will be no refunds.
